

IMPORTANT AUCTION FACTS

SELLERS, It is your responsibility to verify the information on your catalog page (s) and report any changes to the sale company immediately.

ALL PARTICIPANTS, Are bound by the Terms and Conditions of sale and are responsible for knowing and understanding them prior to Sale.

EXAMINE HORSES PRIOR TO BIDDING

ANNOUNCEMENTS, Pay close attention to announcements from the auction podium as they take precedence over printed materials. . Announcements always pertain to information that is NOT on the catalog page. Awareness of such announcements is the buyer's responsibility.

CAUTION, All persons attending the auction do so at their own risk and are urged to use caution while on the premises.

BUYERS AGREEMENT, After making a winning bid, buyers are asked to remain seated until a sale clerk can deliver a buyers agreement. Buyers shall complete and sign the "acknowledgement of purchase" and should confirm the correct hip number and price before signing.

PAYMENT, All accounts must be paid in full at the time of sale. Any check not honored for any reason will be turned over to the County District Attorneys for Collection and charges.

METHOD OF PAYMENT, shall be cash, cashiers check, travelers check or personalized bank check which has been approved by officials of auction management.

SALE COMPANY WARRANTY, There is no implied warranty by the Sale Company, Auctioneers or Sale Catalog Pedigree Company as to the merchantability or fitness for particular purpose of any horse offered in this auction. Prospective bidders are cautioned that warranties on all horses selling are only stated in Terms and Conditions of Sale. There is also no guarantee from Sales Company or Auctioneers as to the soundness of limb or organ.

Neither the Sale Company nor the Sale Catalog Company will be held responsible for providing information as to multiple embryos (foals of the same year) and/or embryo transfers out of mares or dams in sale; nor will either be held liable in any way for buyer's belated awareness of such information.
